# What is AquaEd?

AquaEd is Stevenage Leisure Ltd's successful swimming lessons scheme, teaching aquatic skills to thousands of children and adults each week using the ASA Learn to Swim Pathway for teaching swimming. As well as giving you a skill for life and improving your safety in and around water, being able to swim can open a whole new world, offering the chance to participate in other water based activities or progress in to competitive swimming.

# Why AquaEd?

## **Quality Teachers**

All of our swimming teachers are ASA qualified to a high standard and are committed to their continual professional development. They attend courses and workshops in order to ensure that their knowledge is up to date and that they deliver effective and enjoyable classes. Throughout every lesson, the teacher will look to provide a variety of different fun based activities to help the swimmers learn new skills and they will provide

feedback and instruction to help each individual swimmer develop.

### **Continuous Programme**

The AquaEd programme runs every day (including bank holidays) for 50 weeks of the year, with a 2 week break over the Christmas / New Year holidays. We understand that everyone is an individual, so our continuous programme means that participants will progress through the programme at their own pace. # Swimmers development pathway

# How to get started

Contact your local AquaEd centre to leave your details. If there is space available on the scheme, you will be able to enrol straight away. If there is not currently space, you will be contacted as soon as a space does become available

#### **Payment**

AquaEd lessons are paid for by 12 equal monthly direct debit payments, which allows you to spread the cost monthly, rather than paying a lump sum each term. This also removes the inconvenience of queing at reception when payments are due and takes away the hassle of remembering payment dates.

This Direct Debit payment will entitle you to 1 lesson per week, and access to casual swimming sessions subject to bather loads for £1 per visit. You will not be tied in to a contract and you do not have to pay for a minimum length of time, although we do ask for 1 month's notice if you wish to cancel your lessons.

Some centre's operate Adult & Baby, Adult & Child, Pre-school and Rookie Lifeguard classes as term time only courses, which you may be required to pay for upfront on a termly basis, or weekly on a casual basis. Please ask for information on this directly from your local centre.
